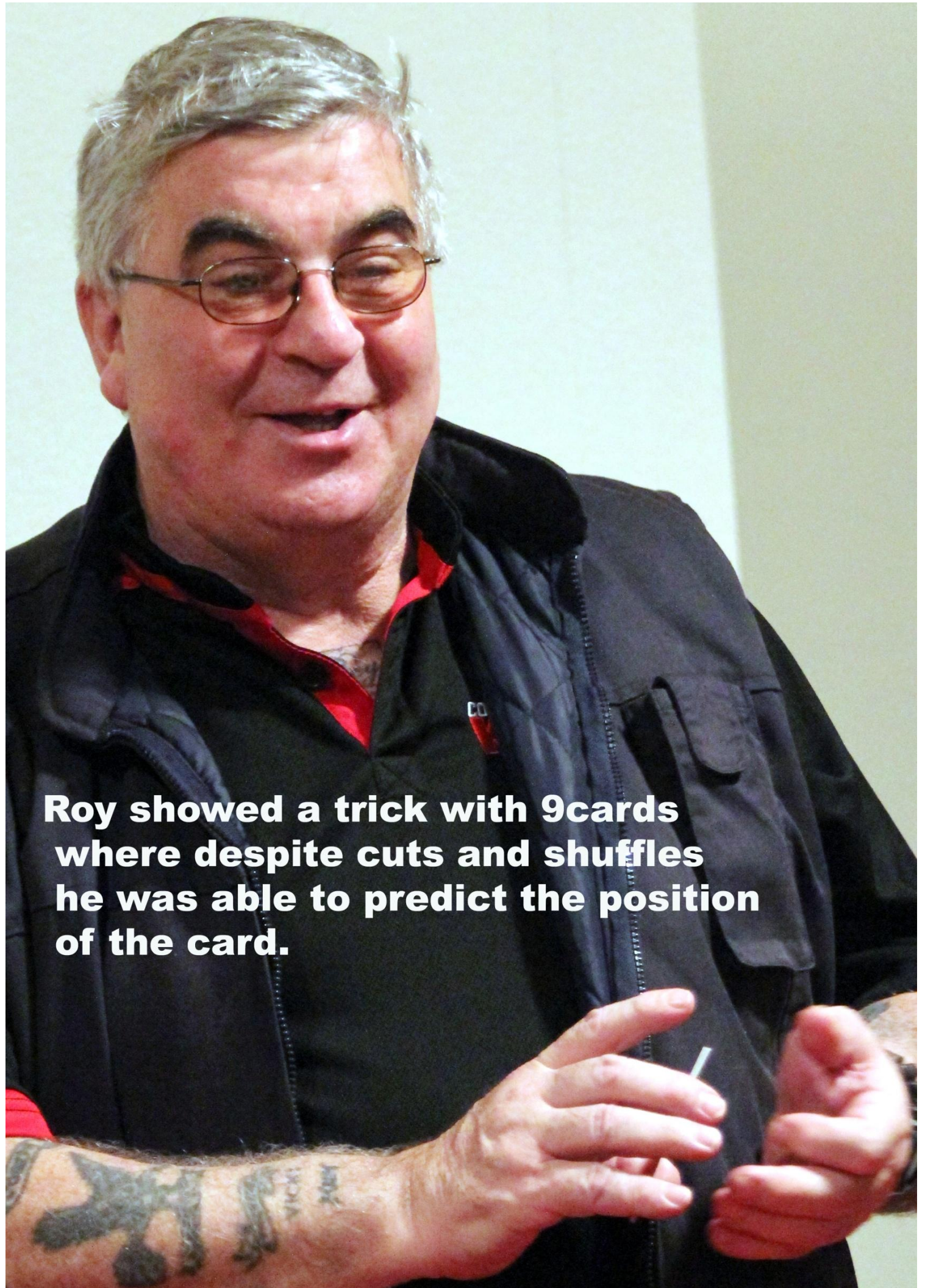






**Mike showed a roughing

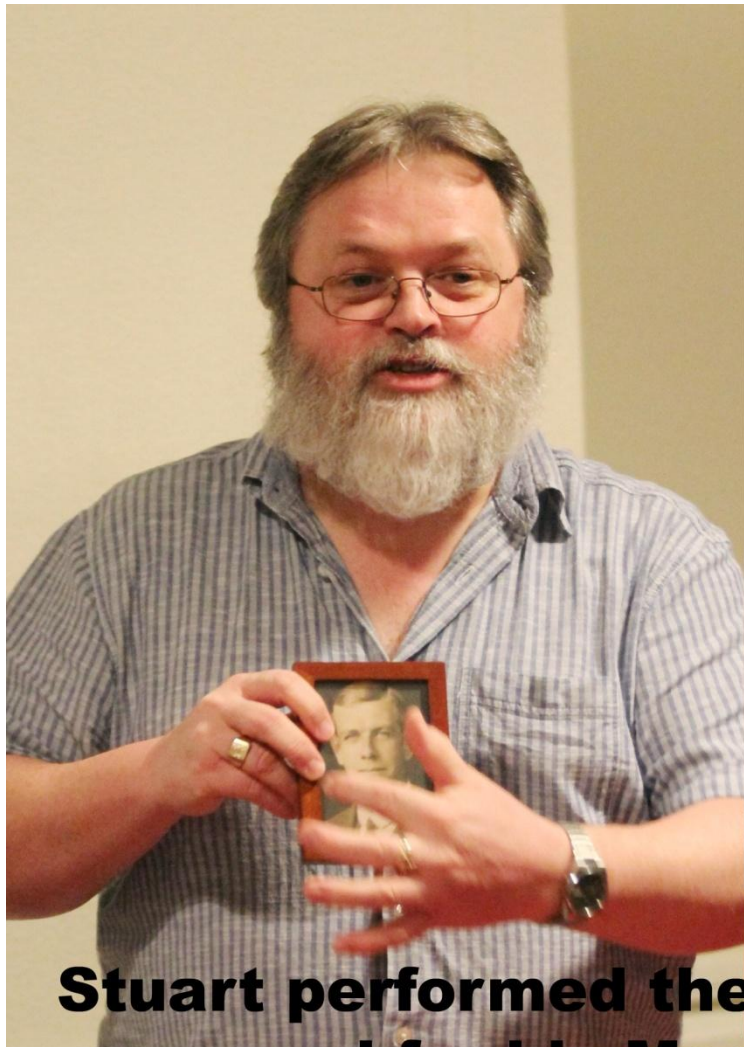

**Charlie performed a poker trick with four winning hands.**



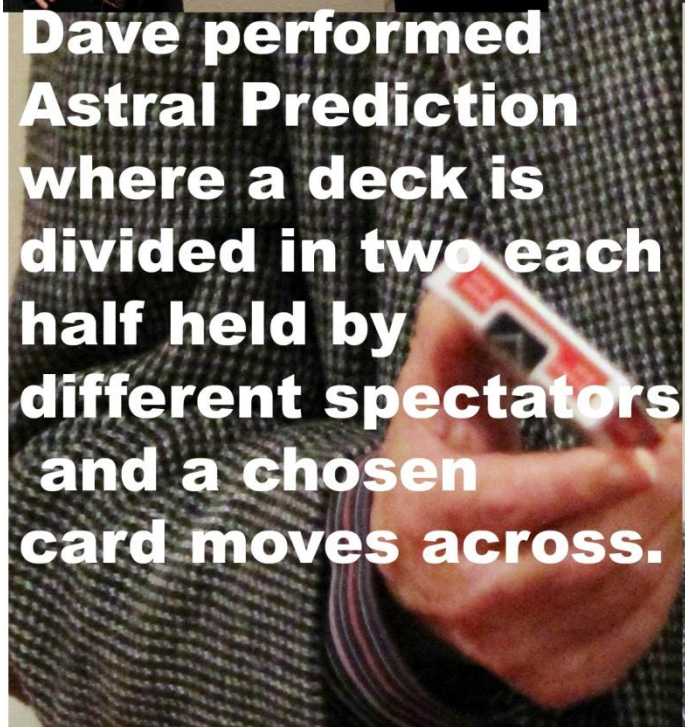


**Colin put a pen into a sealed lemonade bottle using Skycap.**
